#### Duo Portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip in Royal Attire

Queen Elizabeth II and her husband Prince Philip preparing for state visit to India, Pakistan, Nepal and Iran. In this photo, taken at Buckingham Palace in January 1961, the Queen is wearing a pale pink and white embroidered evening gown, the Russian Fringe tiara, and the Sash and Star of the Order of the Garter. On her left shoulder are the Family Orders. Prince Philip is wearing the full dress uniform of an Admiral of the fleet. His decorations include the Sash and Star of the Order of the Garter and the Star of Grand Master of the Order of the British Empire. The Queen and Prince Philip arrived in New Delhi on January 21st, on the first stop of their Royal tour.



#### Queen Elizabeth II's Accession to the Throne

Coronation portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and the Duke of Edinburgh taken on 2nd June 1953. Elizabeth was crowned Queen at Westminster Abbey following the death of her father on 6th February 1952. She wore a gown commissioned from Norman Hartnell which was embroidered with floral emblems for the countries of the Commonwealth. These included the English Tudor rose, Scots thistle, Welsh leek, Irish shamrock, Australian wattle, Canadian maple leaf, New Zealand fern, and South African protea.
